➤ **Ballot by mail** – expect a green envelope around Oct. 10th
Ballot not received by October 14? Call 520.724.4330

Mark and return your ballot as soon as possible. **Vote for every Democrat** and choose YES on Proposition 208. *Sign the white envelope*, provide your phone number, and then place in the yellow envelope. Do not add a stamp!

It's important to return your ballot early:

- **Mail by October 19.** (Not after Oct. 27!)
- Or, drop ballot at your local collection center

Forgot to return it early? Take to any polling location on Nov. 3.
