

JUST SAY NO TO (NEARLY) ALL BALLOT REFERENDUMS

The Arizona Supreme Court has struck down the only statewide ballot initiative supported by Democrats. Proposition 212 would have set eligibility and income limits and brought some transparency to the abuses within the ESA School Voucher Program. The Arizona Supreme Court ruled in favor of the Republican challenge to initiative signatures and it will not appear on the November ballot. Each question that remains on the ballot is a Republican Referendum put there because Governor Hobbs vetoed extremist purely partisan bills that would have caused public harm.
